
Steer Auction Committee Perseverance & Leadership Awards

High Bidders again worked this year to provide Helping Hand Awards to two (2) students who have shown determination in overcoming obstacles and adversity and showing lasting leadership in preparing for the Houston Livestock Show & Rodeo™.

Our first Awardee is William Wolf of Brock, Texas....William is also a first with us. We reviewed applications for the Steer Awards on Thursday afternoon, March 16th picking William for one of our awards. Then on the evening of Saturday, March 18th William was a calf scrambler who was awarded a Hard Luck Calf that we were the Donor of, so William is a two time winner with us.

William wrote that he has been showing pigs for 8 years and this is his first time showing steers.

William's Ag-Teacher wrote that William is diagnosed with downs syndrome and has been working very hard with his show pigs and steer with having over 70 surgeries in the past 17 years and still has the love and happiness to push through. He has had many breathing, foot, bone and heart issues, and takes many medications every day just to move around. Further his teacher stated that William loves his steer, Big Red....walking, washing and brushing him everyday, and even though Big Red has stepped on his foot so many times, he still loves it, saying "Ouch". This is the first time showing steers and William says "I am going to make sale!"





Our second Awardee wished to remain Anonymous.... She started by saying she was willing to bet no one has worse luck than she does. For the past six years she has had steers die by bloat or either a freak accident. However her senior year seems to be the "Cherry" on top. In the fall of 2022 the steer she planned on showing this year was snake bit. Going to the barn before dawn to feed, she found something wrong with her steer, Maverick, he was struggling to stand and was shaking. With the help of the vet they were able to reverse the effect of the poisonous venom. She then took one day at a time with Maverick and with her hard work results began to show. She stated that by showing a bit of perseverance and some TLC to Maverick she can now enter the ring confidently and be proud of her hard work. She states that she has learned life is a battle, but with perseverance anything is possible.
